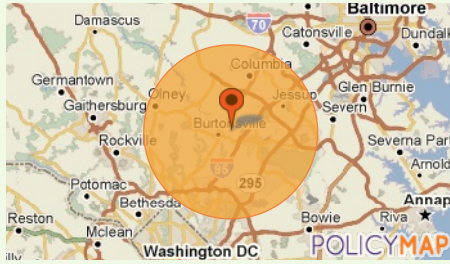

Racial Characteristics:

Of the people living in this area in between 2012-2016, 41.85% are White, 30.39% are African American, 19.05% are Hispanic, 11.7% are Asian, 0.06% are either Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, 0.28% are American Indian or Alaskan Native, 11.76% are of "some other race" and 3.95% are of two or more races. In the table below, the percentage of the population that each segment represents in the report area is compared to the percent it represents in the state.

Between 2000 and 2012-2016, the White population changed by -11.77%, the African American population by 35.18%, and Asian population by 51.93%. The number of Hispanics changed by 104.76%.

Immigration:

Data from the U.S. Census Bureau for 2012-2016 indicate that 228,132 people or 30.08% of the population living in this area were "foreign born". Census defines foreign born as anyone who is not a U.S. citizen at birth. This area is located in Maryland, which, according to the Department of Homeland Security, was home to 26,077 people who were granted Legal Permanent Residence status in 2016. Those LPRs, or "green cards", represent 2.2% of green cards issued in the nation that year.
